EXPLORING THE WORD

Trinity Sunday Year A focuses on God as community. God is the Lover (Father), the Beloved (Son), and the Love which flows between them (Holy Spirit). The love of the Trinity makes God completely one. The readings for Trinity Sunday Year A also remind us that our salvation is a gift of God's love and grace, not something we can earn or deserve by our own merits. The Father sent His only Son, Jesus Christ, to redeem us from sin and death and to reconcile us with Him. The Son, by His death and resurrection, made it possible for us to share in His divine life and to become children of God. The Holy Spirit, poured out on us in Baptism and Confirmation, empowers us to live as faithful disciples of Christ and to bear witness to His gospel in the world. Moreover, the Trinity reveals that we are created in the image and likeness of God, as beings who are meant to live in relationships of love and communion with others. We are called to imitate the triune God by loving one another as He has loved us, by sharing our lives and resources with those in need, by forgiving one another as we have been forgiven, and by building communities of faith, hope, and charity. As Catholics, we are called to reflect this same unity in our own lives. We are called to love one another and to work together in unity for the sake of the Gospel.

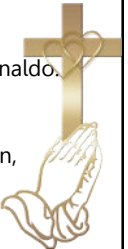
