Mass Readings for next week 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A First Reading – Isaiah 55:10-11:

The Lord's word is likened to rain that nourishes the earth, promising that it will accomplish its intended purpose without returning void.

Responsorial Psalm - Psalm 65:

The land's fruitful yield is a result of divine intervention, leading to joy and celebration.

Second Reading – Romans 8:18-23:

Current sufferings are minimal compared to the future glory awaiting God's children. All creation yearns for this liberation and shares in the anticipation of redemption.

Gospel - Matthew 13:1-23:

Jesus shares a parable about a sower who scattered seeds, symbolizing the spreading of God's word. The seeds fell on different types of soil, representing various responses to the message. Some seeds produced abundant fruit, while others were hindered by thorns, rocky ground, or birds. Jesus explains the meaning of each element, highlighting the importance of receptive hearts for the growth and understanding of God's teachings.

EXPLORING THE WORD

The readings for the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A tell of how our relationship with God helps us grow, which in turn allows our lives to bear fruit. The first reading explains that God's Word is like the rain, which falls on the earth and makes it fertile. The second reading reminds us that a new creation is going to emerge. And in the gospel Jesus tells the parable of the sower and explains that our hearts must be ready to receive the Word of God.
