EXPLORING THE WORD

The readings for the 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time for Year A focus on mercy and forgiveness. In the first reading we are told we must forgive each other for "wrath and anger are hateful things". The psalm reminds us

that God shows us mercy. The 2nd reading tells us to live for Christ instead of ourselves. In the Gospel

Jesus teaches about forgiveness using a parable of a servant forgiven a huge debt but who then refuses to forgive a smaller debt. The master,

angry at this hypocrisy, punishes him. Jesus warns that we must forgive others wholeheartedly. Jesus tells parables about mercy and tells Peter

that we must forgive "seventy times seven" times.
