Christmas Message from Fr Craig

Over the past year the parish has continued to grow and is showing no signs of slowing down, in November we added a new Sunday Mass at 5pm to accommodate the growing numbers attending Masses at St Luke's, with now over 2,000 people who regularly attend one of the Sunday Masses and call St Luke's home. On the 1st of May, the feast of St Joseph the worker we celebrated our second anniversary in the new church.

As we draw to the end of 2023 and get ready to welcome in the new year, the parish office will have a couple of staff changes. After two and a half years, we farewell Joseph who has assisted in the parish office in many ways and managed our social media. Joseph goes on next year to pursue a career in teaching as he begins an internship at Rosmini College on the North Shore. We are extremely grateful for his many contributions to St Luke's and wish him all the best as he begins this new chapter in his life. We also welcome new to the staff Sr Lyra RSM as Pastoral Coordinator and Lima Moefana as Parish Assistant, who will both be staring in the new year. I am also pleased to announce that Bishop Steve has appointed Fr Larry Rustia to be Assistant Priest here at St Luke's, please join me in welcoming them to the parish team.

As a parish we celebrated the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Holy Communion for 76 children. At the Easter vigil, we welcomed 19 people into the Church through the RCIA/C (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults/Children) program. There were 70 baptisms and 15 weddings held here over the past year. We have also had some sad occasions with the death of several parishioners, and a number of internments on our memorial garden, which adds to the dignity and sacredness of the church grounds.

My thanks to all who involved on parish council, finance, liturgy, and fundraising committees who assist me in leading our parish and our various cultural groups who continue be involved in the life of the parish, as they encouraged others to be actively involved in the parish. We have tasted numerous morning teas after Mass and experienced some beautiful liturgical celebrations. Also, to those who volunteer in many and various ways thank you for making St Luke's such a beautiful welcoming community.

My thanks to Celia and Joseph for their tireless assistance throughout the year, and on their behalf and myself, I wish to take the opportunity of thanking you all for your support and love, and wish you and your families a very Happy, Holy and Joyful Christmas Season.
