EXPLORING THE WORD

Today's reading has many allusions to Baptism. The healing of the man born blind invites us to focus on the physical and spiritual aspects of sight and light. Through the man's encounter with Jesus, the man born blind is healed, his sight is restored, and his conversion to discipleship begins. This man gradually comes to a greater understanding about who Jesus is and what it means to be his disciple, while the Pharisees (those who should see) are the ones who remain blind. The final revelation and moment of enlightenment comes when the man born blind encounters Jesus again. Having heard the news of his expulsion, Jesus seeks out this man and reveals himself to him as the Son of Man. In this moment, the man born blind shows himself to be a man of faith and worships Jesus. Jesus replies by identifying the irony of the experience of many who encounter Jesus: Those who are blind will now see, and those who think they now see will be found to be blind.
