EXPLORING THE WORD

Today's readings demonstrate the healing power of Jesus and his ability to rid us of what is unclean in our lives. The Gospel recalls how Jesus healed a leper. The confidence of the leper in Jesus' ability to heal him is evident in the words of his request. But his words can also be read as a challenge to Jesus, asking just how far Jesus was willing to extend himself in order to heal someone.

After this healing, it became difficult for Jesus to travel freely. The cured man spread the word about Jesus' healing power. Even when Jesus was in deserted places, people sought him out in search of his healing.
