PALM SUNDAY 24.03.2024

First Reading Isaiah 50:4-7 Responsorial Psalm Psalm 22:8-9,17-18,19-20,23-24 Second Reading Philippians 2:6-11 Gospel Mark 14:1-15:47 **EXPLORING THE WORD** During Holy Week, we prayerfully remember the events of Jesus' passion and death. As we meditate on the cross, we ask again and anew what it means to make the statement of faith that Jesus, in his obedient suffering and dying, revealed himself to us as God's Son. In Mark's telling of the passion narrative, Jesus understood his death to have been preordained, and he accepted this death in obedience to God's will. Jesus understood his anointing in Bethany as an anticipation of his burial, and he

announced that this story would be told together with the Gospel throughout the world. Jesus predicted his betrayal by Judas as well as Peter's denial. At his arrest, Jesus acknowledged that the preordained time had arrived. After he was sentenced to death, Jesus did not speak again until his final cry from the cross. The Roman centurion affirmed what Mark has presented throughout this Gospel: Jesus is the Son of God. Nowhere was this revealed more fully than in his

death on the cross.
