**EXPLORING THE WORD**

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity known as Corpus Christi. This feast invites us to consider what we believe about God, who has revealed himself to us in the Trinity, one God in three Persons. Today's Gospel, the eleven disciples go up the mountain top in Galilee, as Jesus had instructed them through Mary Magdalene and the other Mary. Jesus approaches and commissions them to baptise and teach. Its a task which Jesus had previously prepared his disciples; recall that Jesus had already sent the twelve apostles to preach the Kingdom of God and to heal. Earlier, the Twelve were sent only to the House of Israel; in this final commission, the eleven are told to go to all nations. The mission of Jesus is now to be taken to all people, and the task is to baptize and to teach. As we read this Gospel on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we are reminded that this mystery of faith is meant to be lived. As baptised Christians, we share in the life of the blessed Trinity and seek to invite others to share in God's love.

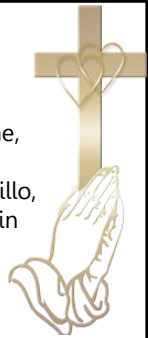
