EXPLORING THE WORD

His family comes to take him away because they think he is beside himself, the scribes think he is possessed by the devil. Jesus points out to them their crazy thinking that he uses the devil to cast out demons. In fact, it is Jesus who ties up Beelzebub, and overcomes him. He concludes with a brief saying about the forgiveness of sins. All sin can be forgiven except for blasphemy against the Holy Spirit. Returning to the frame of family and his teaching on true family, Jesus lays the groundwork when he identifies those guilty of the "eternal sin" as all who interpret God's action through him as a manifestation of evil. (Note that this is in contrast to later Christian generations that view this sin as a refusal to accept God's mercy and forgiveness.) Armed with that insight, Jesus abandons the concept of *natural family* and embraces the idea of *true family*. He is the master of undivided household, whose family members consist of those who hear him and act on the will of God.
