EXPLORING THE WORD

Today's Gospel offers evidence of Jesus' power and authority as he calms the storm. With this event taking place at night, upon water, and in the midst of a storm, the fears of darkness, and the chaotic forces of nature are all evoked. We are in the boat, the storms of life are raging around us, and like the disciples, we may believe that Jesus is unconcerned, or "sleeping." We hope that we will be as familiar with Jesus as his disciples. If we feel that Jesus is sleeping, are we comfortable enough to wake Jesus and present him with our needs? Jesus chides the disciples for their lack of faith and perspective. When we bring our worries to God in prayer, we might just begin to learn to see things from God's perspective. Despite Jesus' earlier explanations of his parables in private, they realise that faith is clearly more than possession of knowledge. Ultimately, this event prompts deeper questions regarding Jesus' identity that will only be answered by the cross.
