**EXPLORING THE WORD**

This week's Gospel and next week's describe how Jesus sent the disciples to minister in his name and the disciples' return to Jesus afterward. After having chosen the Twelve and given them the secret of the kingdom of God, Jesus sends them out and warns them that in some places they will experience a lack of welcome and that some will refuse to hear the message of repentance. Jesus instructs the apostles to preach and to share his authority to heal and to drive out demons. Jesus also instructs them to travel lightly, without the customary food, money, and extra set of clothes. This means that they will depend on the hospitality of others, just as Jesus depended on others. Jesus continues to send us into the world as disciples but like the first disciples, we are not sent alone. Jesus has given us the community of the Church, which strengthens our life of discipleship. In our work with others, we build this community of faith and can invite others to share in it.
