**EXPLORING THE WORD**

In today's Gospel, a man approaches Jesus and inquires about what he must do to inherit eternal life. Jesus replies that one must follow the commandments of the Law of Moses. Jesus then says he must give his possessions to the poor and follow Jesus. Jesus very much wants this man to be his disciple. Just as this Gospel tells us that Jesus loves the man and is sad when he departs, so too, Jesus loves us and is saddened when we are unable to follow him. Jesus reminds his disciples that nothing is impossible with God.

Salvation is determined by our ability to rely completely upon God. Jesus acknowledges that those who have given up everything for the sake of the Gospel will be rewarded. This reward begins now, in the new community that one will gain in this life, and will continue in the eternal age to come. Our personal relationship with Jesus is also an invitation to the community of faith, the Church.
